- are pursuing courses relating to South Asia; and/or
- have a genuine research interest in South Asia.

At the end of the internship, you will be required to submit:

- a research paper (based on a topic determined by ISAS); and
- a report on your internship experience.

DURATION AND STIPEND

The internship will take place from **May to July 2010**.

Each intern will receive a monthly stipend of **S\$800.00**.
